From 27th January 2022, Government Plan B COVID-19 restrictions were lifted and this Risk Assessment has been updated accordingly.

A child with the virus who is asymptomatic may spread the virus but is no more likely to spread it than an adult)</p> <p>Parents</p> <p>Leaders</p> <p>Users of the building within 72 hours of occupancy</p>	<p>Notify all parties that they are not to attend the club or enter the building if they are exhibiting any of the typical symptoms of Covid-19 i.e. a raised temperature, a new & persistent dry cough, loss of taste or loss of smell, or if they have received a positive LFD test result.</p>	<p>Hanney Chapel already has notices at the entrance notifying anyone with these symptoms that they should not enter.</p> <p>The risk assessment will be posted on the Chapel website.</p>	To be reviewed in February 2023, or when government restrictions and guidance change.
	<p>All who attend</p>	<p>Good hand hygiene will be encouraged throughout the duration of the club. All who enter the building will be directed to use the hand sanitizer at the entrance.</p> <p>The children will be reminded to wash their hands thoroughly after using the toilet.</p> <p>Good respiratory hygiene will be encouraged by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach.</p>	<p>Children will be reminded of these requirements regularly.</p>	

		<p>Additional Cleaning. If a child with symptoms uses a toilet while waiting to be collected by a parent, the toilet will be cleaned immediately.</p>	<p>The cleaning protocol is outlined in the Chapel Risk Assessment.</p>	
		<p>Symptoms Shown. If a child develops symptoms of the Covid-19 virus while at the club, they will be moved away from the other children to a well-ventilated room with adult supervision. The parents should be notified to come and collect them.</p>	<p>A register with parents' contact details is kept at the club.</p>
